- **College and University Students Scholarship** – open to all students who are enrolled as a full-time student for the fall of 2022 term in a Risk Management and Insurance Program in Central New York.
- **High School Senior Scholarship** – open to all senior high school students planning to attend college in the fall of 2022 as a full-time student.
